The tulips are blooming in Georgia, and we are ready for our travel season to take off! It is amazing to sit back and watch MMO teams leave without any Edmondson family members on board – this shows how much MMO is growing! Our first such team of the year was in January, hosted by Missionary Carl Gormley. We had 17 team members run an optical clinic in which 1,007 patients heard the gospel, 921 patients received glasses, and 662 people accepted Christ as Savior. What a week! Pray for Hope Baptist Church as they follow up on all these converts.

In February, Kelly took a quick trip down to the Rearick Surgical Center in Honduras to prepare patients for the upcoming week of general surgeries. Kelly was able to take histories and perform physicals on 24 patients eager to have long awaited surgeries of gall bladder removals and hernia repairs. When the surgical team arrived in March, there were 16 patients who received life-changing surgeries. Each patient received prayer and the gospel conversation. Beacon Baptist Church of El Progreso is excited to follow up with every single patient. Please pray for the healing of bodies and souls.

Bradley has had the opportunity to preach at several churches already this year, as well as speaking in a break-out session at Pensacola Christian College's annual Bible Conference. Hundreds of students passionate about missions showing up to be challenged to reach the world for Christ. It was an encouraging week, and we are always praying that young people would surrender their hearts to full-time missions.
