In the first week of May, NBM was able to finalize and execute a project that has been in the works for the past several months. Out of a desire to provide higher quality printed Gospel tracts for our church planters, NBM has pursued a "Personalized Tract Initiative" (PTI). This project has been in the works since the Fall of 2021, so we are excited to finally share the results with you!





Towards the end of 2021, the PTI was started by locating an in-country printer to produce quality Gospel tracts at a more reasonable price. The idea was to get tracts printed that not only shared the Gospel but had relevant information to connect people to local churches. NBM contacted our pastors to see who would be interested in obtaining these personalized tracts. From there we gathered specific information and implemented it into the design and printing. Over a dozen pastors responded, and the tracts were printed and are being distributed this Spring!



Pastor Mark Manning did the design and layout work, implementing the details given for each specific pastor and church. From there Pastor Moises (director of IBIN) took the digital files to the Nicaragua-based printer. Once printed, NBM leadership was able to go out and distribute the tracts so these men could begin using them within their communities. Between the 13 churches



that communicated a need, we were able to get a total of 70,000 tracts printed! The pictures on this newsletter are just of few of the pastors we were able to get these materials to.

We are so grateful for your financial and prayerful support; it enabled us to get useful and high-quality tools in the hands of these men. Please continue praying for them and that these tracts would be an asset in reaching their communities for Christ!
